Rev. Dr. Stephanie Lutz Allen is fascinated with how to lead change productively in congregations. First as a pastor for 20 years, she brings first-hand experience knowing the rigors and joys of leading a congregation. She led change in various settings, particularly helping one congregation buck their aging trend and build a generation of leadership within new young families to the church. Currently, she serves as consultant to congregations and judicatories, and as interim pastor for congregations. Her seminars integrate the best research in the social sciences and theological reflection, rather than the passing fads of the latest gurus. She draws upon her research in leadership from a M.S. degree in Industrial/Organizational Psychology and a D.Min from Luther Seminary in Congregational Leadership for Mission. For her D.Min thesis research, she studied in depth five “missional” congregations and their patterns of leadership and management. She is ordained in the PC (U.S.A.).
