It is with a heavy heart that we mourn the sudden, instant death of the Rev. David Daniel, pastor of Rock Creek Presbyterian Church in Tallula, where he had been serving for 14 years. He and his wife, the Rev. Kay Daniel, pastor of First Federated Church of Clayton, and also a beloved member of our presbytery, were both involved in a tragic head-on vehicle collision this morning just west of Springfield. Kay is currently in Memorial Medical Center in Springfield, where she is lucid and open to visits. She requests prayers for the passengers of the other car, one who is in critical condition. Please keep Kay, David's family and loved ones, and their church communities in your prayers-especially Rock Creek, which has now experienced the tragedy of a third pastor who died while serving. May we all share solidarity in ministries of presence, healing, and hope, in the name of the God of resurrection to whom we belong.
