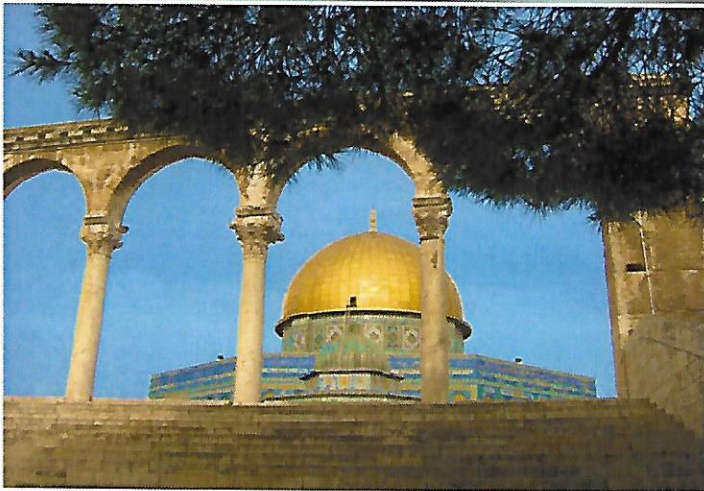


# ABRAHAM'S CHILDREN SEARCHING FOR JUSTICE IN ISRAEL & PALESTINE
